A guest can use a member's boat in the lake (with a guest tag) but any boats found to be a non-member will be asked to leave and the decal will be removed. Any boat decals purchased for non-member boats can be returned to the LPCC for a full refund; for this year only.

Throughout the season (and year) Tom McMullen, our Beach Manager, continues to be diligent and dedicated to keeping the community and the surrounding lake safe. As the weather improves, he confronts many trespassers in and around the lake. Aside from being the steward of our dam – maintaining water levels from pending storms, he surveils our property daily to deter vandals and the many who ignore the signage to our private status. THANK YOU TOM!!

If you've driven on Taunton Blvd., you would have noticed the **NEW Pedestrian light** erected at our Main Beach entrance. The project is almost complete and we anticipate PSE&G connecting the electric that will provide a safer "commute" to Main Beach; an important addition this season and for future generations to "cross".

We've also purchased new picnic tables for Main and East Beaches and plan to replace any failing swings to upgrade the areas that are most used. Additionally, we have a member who has volunteered to help upgrade our basketball hoop. Lake Pine Beach & Recreational Facility Rules

In the interest of safety, the LPCC would like to remind its members of the beach and recreational facility rules and regulations. Failure to follow the rules below may result in being asked to leave the beach or recreational facility. **Violators will be prosecuted!**

We thank you in advance for your compliance.

- There are no lifeguards on duty - swim at your own risk.
- Only members that have paid the recreation fee are allowed to use the facilities.
- Members that have not paid this fee will be asked to leave immediately.
- Please remember to wear your badges. Anyone not wearing their badges will be asked to retrieve them before using the beach or recreational facility - no exceptions!
- Persons under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at the beaches.
- No Dogs on the beaches. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed in the swimming or bathing area.
- No glass containers on the beaches.
- No fighting, rowdiness, roughness or conduct that endangers the safety of others shall be permitted.
- No swimming or bathing during an electrical storm.
- Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
- All children in diapers must wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands. Do not wash out soiled diapers in the lake.
- Children should be encouraged to use the rest room before entering the water.
- No motorized vehicles, except emergency and maintenance vehicles, shall be permitted in the bathing area during its use.
- No boating, water skiing, sail boating, windsurfing, scuba diving, or surfboarding shall be permitted in the swimming and bathing areas while in use.
- No fishing within the roped swimming areas.
- Rope drops shall not be permitted except those licensed and inspected by the Department of Community Affairs pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:3-31 through 55.
- Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering the water.
- Everyone must clean up any litter they drop.



Fishing Notice

The LPCC would like to remind members to please refrain from fishing inside the roped swimming areas on beaches. Fishing in the designated swimming areas any time of the year is a danger to everyone. Help ensure a safe swimming season for everyone.

2016 Lake Pine Swimming Program

Session 1 - July 11-15

Session 2 – July 18 -22

Swimming lessons at the Main Beach on Taunton Blvd. - a Lake Pine tradition for over 40 years - directed by Pat Yurcho, long time resident and Water Safety Instructor with the American Red Cross.

*****Course descriptions are guides and lessons are taught to the skill level of students in each class *****

Session 1 July 11, 12, 13, 14 ,(raindate - 15th) / Session 2 July 18, 19, 20. 21 raindate-22nd)

COST \$20

10-10:30 AM– Stroke refinement/improvement- for students who know most swimming strokes but need a review. They can jump or dive off board/dock and can swim without aids, can do front crawl w/coordinated breathing as well as several backstrokes, breast stroke/side stroke and does not rely on doggie paddling. They are very comfortable in deep water. This course reviews and refines skills as well as develops more efficient strokes for better endurance in the water. (usually ages 8-12)

10:45-11:15 AM – Skill and stroke readiness/practice- for students who float, submerge, swim underwater but are still learning to coordinate the front and back strokes and/or rhythmic breathing. Many students jump and dive into deep water but are not truly comfortable. Tending to doggie paddle with face out. They usually have limited stroke knowledge and ability. (approx. ages 6 -8).

11:30-12 noon - Water exploration/primary beginner skills – for students who enjoy the water and will submerge and/or put their face in, some are comfortable with lifting feet and swimming on top or under the water but hesitate to jump into deep water without aids or close parent contact. (approx. ages 5-6)

12:10-12:40 pm – Water exploration/readiness- for students who are reluctant to submerge or put face in the water or are submerging and swimming but are just turning 4 and have had limited swim lessons or group instruction. Attention span may be limited as well as ability to coordinate overhand strokes(ages 4 -5)

(note- ability and coordination of strokes is developmental and age often dictates the speed of learning and mastering strokes / water skills.) All children benefit from review, repetition, practice, encouragement, fun with peers, and play in the water!
