

# **BOARD/COMMITTEE UPDATES**

#### **RULES Refresher**

The Board would like to reiterate that members **must** follow the Rules and Regulations. These can be found on our website and in a coming email to members. These rules are in place for the safety of all and to comply with our insurance coverage. Failure to follow the rules can result in loss of member-in-good-status and thereby having recreation use and other member privileges (including use of docks) suspended. A few recent events necessitate reminder of a few:

#### **Article VIII: Section 1: Beach and Property Rules**

- Children under 10 must be supervised by a designated person aged 16 or older (applicable to all LPCC property including beaches, fields, and courts)
- No person under the age of 16 can be in or on the water without supervision.

#### **Article VIII: Section 7: Fireworks**

The use of any fireworks, firecrackers, sparklers, fountains, or similar devices is prohibited on LPCC property. Fireworks MAY NOT be set off from docks or within or above Lake Pine itself (ie from a canoe or other watercraft).

The Board gives notice that any future use of fireworks as generally defined above in violation of rule above will result in a change of status to "not in good standing" for a period of six months, following the process outlined in the Bylaws. Informing the Board is a good step, but members are urged to call the Medford Police Department's non-emergency number to report such activity. The more frequently they receive calls, the more likely they are to respond.

#### Water Testing

Burlington County mandates weekly testing of each swim area (South, Main, East) from Memorial Day to Labor Day. We contract one of the remaining local testing companies to perform these tests. The results are sent to us and the county each week and we have copies of those stored at South Beach and electronically. Results are also stored on Burlington County's website that has not been updated since June 1: https://www.arcgis.com/apps/dashboards/4c1 a1955af2e44e9849d3f66966ba419

If we test higher than the allowable county threshold, we must test that area again. If we 'fail' two tests, we must close that swim area until a test result under the threshold comes back. We would immediately communicate this closing via email, text, facebook, and by posting signs at the closed beach. We often come back with relatively low numbers, only rarely creeping to the upper limit. Reasons for this higher number include: geese and other animal feces, high temperatures, increased rainfall/runoff. While we can't control the weather, we can refrain from feeding geese and discourage them from the property by annoying them when we come across them (do not harm them, they are a protected species) to make our lake a less habitable place for them.


