MEMBER MEETING MINUTES 6/8/17 7:30 PM

Board members in attendance: Laura Saunders- President (P), Mark Finley- Vice President (VP), Secretary- Maylea Lamborn; Ben Clark- Trustee

Lake Pine Financials:

Operating Acct: \$163,684.91 Lake &Dam Acct: \$45,158.97 Debit Acct: \$6,199.70 Total Balance: \$215,043.58

- Loan status- ahead of schedule with payments-aprox. 25,000 left to pay off.
- \$1,000 was allotted to put new dirt down for the ball field, but will be postponed due to need for additional funds.
- Mark Finley (VP) reviewed member status: Member Status: 335 paid members, 28 non-paid. (79 senior members.) 363 total if all members pay.
- LPCC Website has needs to be updated due to site glitches and needed updates. Remind 101- mobile app for members to opt into to receive text messages on meeting and any alerts in the community.
- "Next door" card received in the mail is a marketing ploy and WAS NOT distributed by LPCC.
- Special Thank You to members who came out Memorial Day weekend to assist putting picnic tables together. Two new picnic tables were added to South Beach. There is a budget for one more table. Laura Sanders (P) attended Medford Twp. Neighborhood Safety Meeting-6/7/17.
- •Interest points taken from the meeting:
- Encouraged people to call if they see anything they feel is suspicious, as it can save homes and safety. No one should feel they are over reacting or feel embarrassed when reporting concerns.
 - Police can be called to report your house will be vacant and they can provide a modicum of surveillance.
 - Crime prevention and services brochures will be placed in the Pine Needle.
- Lake Pine Days- Committee to form within the next couple of weeks.. Looking for volunteers and ideas.
- Encouraged ALL members to ask to see a beach tags, especially if they do not know or have seen people on the beach in the past. Members pay to keep the beaches and community clean and safe, which is one purpose for the tags.
 - Discussed having members participate in a Badge Checker program.
- Remember- Guest tags are to be used with a member accompanying them and members are responsible for guest actions. Guest tags are not to be given to people outside the community.
- Reminder-Boat decals are for LPCC member boats only, not to be given to people outside the community. Additional canoe racks have successfully been added and all slots are rented. East beach slide has been repaired-Main beach slide- sand has been dug out at the bottom. New benches at the ball field have been completed-Beach boxes have been updated and repaired. York rack planned for South beach. Pending repairs and proposed projects:
 - Sink in Men's room in the club house.
 - Sidewalk in front of club house due for repairs- planned for the fall.
 - Discussed-beach swing sets needing to be updated and possibly getting a screen for tennis court.
- Looking to replace the light at the club house parking lot-need tall latter to change the bulb- if any members have resources to assist in light bulb change.
 - South Beach need front end loader to move out sand-may have to wait until next lake lowering.
 - Wood debris piled behind South beach bench (metal/wood) will move out and have landscapers remove
- Tom McMullen commented on how great our volunteer beach cleaners are doing.
- Soccer camp rented field again his summer
- Cars parked close to road must be registered with the township- call ownership with concerns
- Member inquired about getting a GaGa pit for the kids. Members and Board approved funds for the GaGa pit.
- Concerns with people driving across South beach-looking in to barriers to deter driving across beach.
- Canoes can be brought up alongside dock between dock and fishing area. No Canoes or paddled water craft are allowed in swimming areas.
- Members encouraged to attend the Township Zoning Board meeting 6/21/17 at 730pm. Depetris is requesting a variance for a drive through. It is encouraged for LPCC members to attend the meeting to learn and express concerns on how the development t of Taunton Forge is impacting our neighborhood. Current questions are: Traffic impact to our community and who is the anchor store?
